DETAILS OF TOURNAMENT:

- Teams are guaranteed 4 games. Since this is the first year this event has been half ice, each team will likely play for than 4 games depending on registration
- The tournament fee, which includes all gate fees, is \$450.00
- Admission will be confirmed upon receipt of payment and a completed application form.
- Play begins on Friday afternoon and will conclude Sunday.
- A skills competition will be held Saturday. Each team is able to and encouraged to, submit 2 players to participate in the competition.
- Lunch will be provided for all players on Saturday.
- Each player will receive a tournament memento.
- Each player will receive a snack after one of their 4 guaranteed games.

LIONS TYKE TOURNAMENT 2018

- 1. This tournament shall be played under **O.M.H.A.** and **C.M.H.A.** rules. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make decisions regarding the interpretation of the rules and all decisions by the committee are final.
- 2. **House league/local league** teams only, NO select or roster select teams allowed.
- 3. REGISTRATION All teams must register at least one hour before their first scheduled game. One team official must produce originals or approved copies of the team roster, affiliated player lists, and travel permits if applicable. All teams are asked to be ready to play 15 min before their scheduled game time in case start times are ahead of schedule. There is no player sign in.
- 4. The team designated as Home Team in each tournament game will be required to change sweaters should a color conflict arise. Conflict sweaters will be provided.
- 5. Game play will be 4 on 4 format with dressed goalies
- 6. All tournament games will be 44 minutes in length (2- 22 Min Periods)
- 7. Buzzer will be set for 1:00 minute
- 8. No Score will be kept
- 9. No coaches on ice
- 10. On buzzer, players leave puck where it is and go to bench
 - a. Referee will direct players to "leave the puck"
 - b. Players on bench come on the ice and continue to play
 - C. If there are fewer than 4 players on the bench, the active player designated to stay out for the following shift must tag up at the bench prior to racing to play the loose puck
 - d. Both games synchronized through officials

11. GOALTENDER FREEZES PUCK:

- a. Team that shot the puck backs off
- b. Referee blows whistle to indicate shooting team to back off and call out possession of team that now gets the puck
- C. Goaltender gives puck to a teammate to begin play the other way

12. WHEN GOAL IS SCORED

- a. Referee blows whistle to signal goal
- b. Scoring team backs off to let the team that was scored on retrieve the puck out of the net
- C. Play resumes with team that was scored on going on offense

13. **PENALTIES**:

- a. Referee puts arm up to signal penalty call
- b. If offending team has the puck it is a change of possession as indicated by the Referee and puck goes to the other team
- C. At the buzzer at the end of the shift the referee tells the coach what the penalty was and who got it
- d. Offending player misses next shift, team still plays full strength
- 14. Decisions of the referees are final and not subject to protest.
- 15. Jamboree format: The Convener reserves the right to change the format of the tournament should it be deemed necessary.
- 16. Rules are subject to change. Final version will be published in the program.
- 17. If tournament gets behind. Flooding will be done after every second game
- 18. OVERALL GOAL IS FOR EVEYONE TO HAVE FUN!
